# Youth Orchestra of Palm Beach County Orchestra Summer Camp -- Music to Your Ears!

The Youth Orchestra of Palm Beach County is pleased to present an orchestra day camp at a *new location* - Old School Square in Delray Beach. The program is offered in two one-week sessions, June 15-19 and June 22-26. Campers may attend one or both sessions.

Orchestra Summer Camp is open to all young musicians (string, woodwind, brass and percussion), ages 7 to 18.

Daily activities will include music theory essentials, instrumental technique, chamber music ensembles, sectional instruction and orchestra rehearsals. Campers will present a concert for family and friends at the conclusion of each session.

Camp will be held under the direction of YOPBC Music Director Mr. Manuel Capote, with Conductor Mrs. Susan Rodberg, and additional professional musicians who will participate as Sectional Coaches and Guest Musicians.

For the first time, YOPBC is partnering for camp with Old School Square Cultural Arts Center and National Historic Site, a nationally recognized historic preservation project. YOPBC Orchestra Summer Camp will take place in the restored early 20th Century school building including the Crest Theatre, Vintage Gymnasium, restored classrooms, and lawn. Old School Square is located at the corner of Atlantic and Swinton Avenues in downtown Delray Beach.

Campers may choose to ride to and from camp on Tri-Rail and take the free Delray Shuttle "Downtown Roundabout" from the Delray station to Old School Square. (Train fares not included. YOPBC does not provide chaperones on Tri-Rail or Shuttle.)

## Camp Schedule

### Monday through Friday (Both Sessions)

Music and events will differ in each session so campers attending both sessions will experience a variety of activities. It is not necessary for campers to attend Session I in order to participate in Session II.

## Camp Fees
